Requirements:

Vive Pro 2 (<u>https://www.vive.com/eu/product/vive-pro2/overview/</u>) 2x Base stations or more (either version 1.0 (<u>https://www.vive.com/eu/accessory/base-station/</u>) or 2.0 (<u>https://www.vive.com/eu/accessory/base-station2/</u>)) The full kit is also available on Vive Pro 2 (<u>https://www.vive.com/eu/product/vive-pro2-full-kit/overview/</u>) VR-Compatible PC

SteamVR installed on PC (https://store.steampowered.com/app/250820/SteamVR/)

- 1. Place your base stations in **opposite corners** of your playing area.
 - a. Plug your base stations into power outlets and set up their channels to either
 A & B (for two base stations) or A & C (If more than two are used)
- 2. Connect the Vive Pro 2 to your PC by connecting the cables from the headset into the provided **Link Box**. Plug in the headset's **power adapter** as well.
- 3. Install SteamVR on your PC from the Steam store
- 4. When SteamVR's download is finished, you can start it up.
- 5. Now you'll be able to connect your controllers to it by holding the **system button** (below the trackpad)
 - a. In SteamVR, navigate to the Devices menu and click on **Pair Controller,** and follow the prompts
- 6. Run the Room-Scale setup inside SteamVR by navigating into the menu and choosing "**Run Room Setup**". Follow the on-screen instructions and choose the options suitable for your needs.
- 7. Now the process is complete, and your setup is ready to be used.
